WHAT IS NYSSH?

Supportive housing provides survivors of domestic violence, and other vulnerable populations who have experienced the trauma of homelessness, abuse, and loss, with a safe, affordable place to live alongside services to help them rebuild their lives. **The New York State Supportive Housing Program (NYSSH) has funded this housing since 1987, but at a rate that has barely changed since its inception.**


NYSSH NEEDS ADDITIONAL FUNDING URGENTLY



NYSSH AT NEW DESTINY

New Destiny operates 5 NYSSH buildings, where we house hundreds of children and adults impacted by domestic violence. NYSSH is supposed to fund basic case management and security, but it falls tragically short.

This enormous shortfall leaves NYSSH staff chronically underpaid and domestic violence survivors unsafe and without the services needed to recover from the trauma.



Governor Hochul and the NYS Legislature Must Save NYSSH:

- Increase funding for NYSSH by \$32 Million in FY26
- Pass the Supportive Housing Modernization Act (S136/A2134) to increase NYSSH contract rates up to ESSHI levels over 5 years

*Nonprofits had to close their doors, merge with another agency, or stop providing supportive housing.
