Children in New Destiny apartments are having their wishes come true this holiday season thanks to the support of donors at Antenna Group, Albanese Organization, and Avalon Bay.

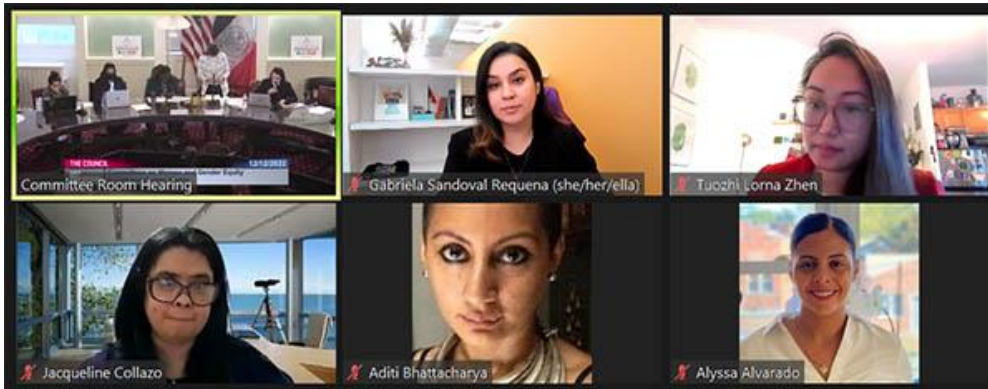

Advocacy

On December 12th, [New Destiny testified before the New York City Council Women & Gender Equity and Civil & Human Rights Committees in support of Intro 148](#), a legislation that will amend the definition of domestic violence under the Human Rights Law to recognize economic abuse as a form of domestic violence and extend existing protections for survivors who have experienced financial abuse. Up to 99% of survivors experience economic abuse, while also being stripped from their social safety nets. Economic violence has long-lasting effects and significantly limits access to housing, employment, and other resources.
